We are committed to the prevention of work-related accidents, illness and injury and seek continual improvement of our health and safety performance by setting objectives and targets.

This policy applies to all of DDG business activities, including our offices, warehouse locations and all on site and offshore working.

We will meet this commitment by:

- Adhering to our Core Values and EHS Principles and referring to them when making key decisions in relation to Health & Safety.
- Continuously improving the mental health environment and culture of the company by identifying, eliminating, or minimising harmful processes, procedures and behaviours.
- Recognising that no business objective will compromise safe working practice.
- Holding employees, supervisors and management accountable for the safety of personnel in their charge.
- Complying with legal and other requirements, responsibilities and obligations under the relevant health and safety legislation and relevant codes of practice and guidance.
- Providing information and training as necessary to ensure the health and safety of employees.
- Consulting and participating with worker / worker representatives regarding matters of Occupational health and safety.
- Using a 'Hierarchy of Controls' approach to remove, reduce or otherwise suitably and sufficiently control significant hazards and risks to employees.
- Setting quantifiable safety objectives and targets that result in improvement. Regularly monitor and report performance against these targets.

Our Responsibility

The Group Managing Director is responsible for Health and Safety at DDG and will ensure that this policy is implemented, maintained and reviewed for continuing suitability. All employees of DDG have a responsibility to assist the company to meet these objectives and provide feedback for continual improvement.
